

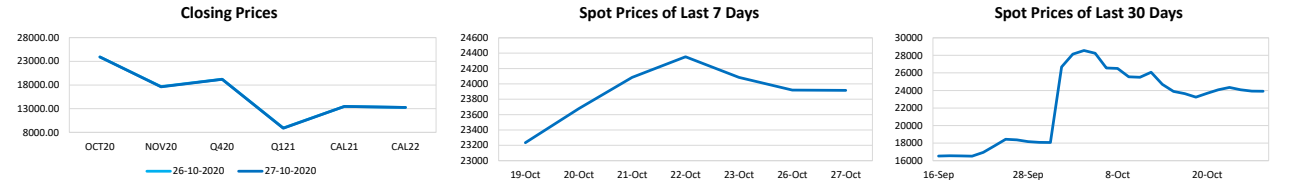

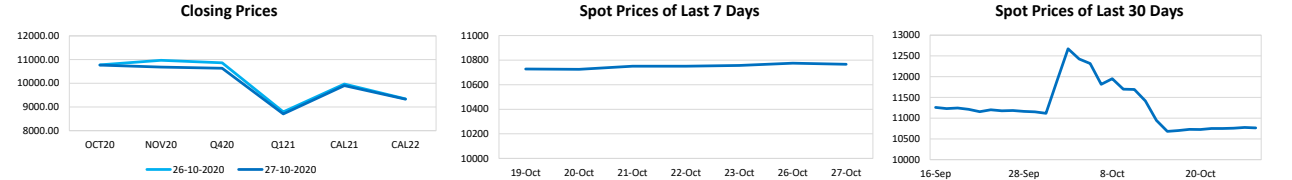

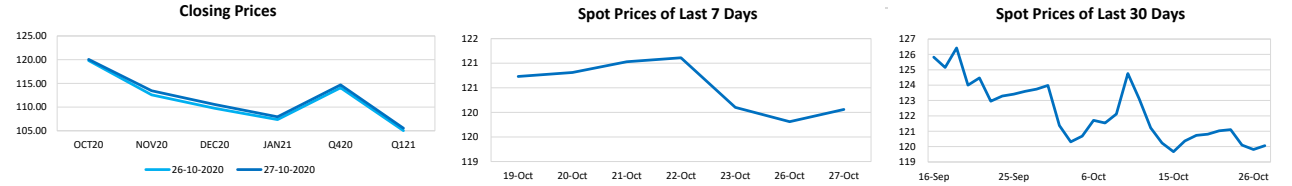

Market continues to firm up slightly in the Atlantic, with more shorter trips fixed as well as some front haul. South America remains stagnant and the Pacific lost a little more value today.



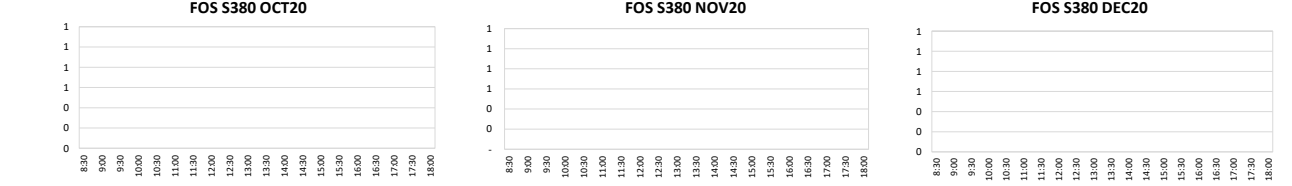

Iron ore recovered some of the lost ground on Tuesday as investors awaited the outcome of China's Communist Party plenum. According to data from MySteel, Australian and Brazilian delivery also picked up since port maintenance ended in early October, leading to almost a weekly surplus of 2 million tonnes at port against port evacuation.
