




Rates in the Atlantic this week came under severe pressure with sizeable losses on the respective routes with absent mineral demand and long tonnage counts alleviated by ballaster numbers from the east in recent weeks only compounding to the situation.

Iron ore futures surged above \$90 for the first time since March as investors look ahead of the upcoming Two Sessions meeting in China. It has been widely speculated that further stimulus measures would be announced during the party conferences starting from 21st May. Stricter environmental control and sintering cuts could also be imposed ahead of the conference, according to some sources.

Oil is up amid supply cuts by OPEC and other major producers, bright spots are also emerging on the demand side. Data released today showed China's daily crude oil use rebounded in April as refineries ramped up operations. However, an armada of ships filled with Saudi crude heading to American shores is raising concern that storage tanks may fill again just as a U.S. glut shows signs of easing.
